## About the CSTT

Commission for Scientific and Technical Terminology was established on October 01, 1961 in pursuance of a Presidential Order dated April 27, 1960 with the objective to evolve technical terminology in all Indian Languages. The Commission was established under clause (4) of Article 344 of the Constitution of India as a follow up of recommendations of a Committee in this regard. The main function of the Commission is to evolve standard terminology, propagate its use and distribute it widely. In the process of evolution of scientific and technical terminology and reference material in Hindi and Indian Languages, the Commission shall have collaboration of State Governments, Universities, Regional Text-Book Boards and State Granth Academies.

The Commission for Scientific and Technical Terminology organizes seminars, workshops, conferences, training programs in various institutes/universities/colleges/commission premises with the aim of propagating the terminology developed by CSTT. Participants are introduced to the principles of technical terminology preparation, various aspects of problems and their formulation through these programs.

In this context the Commission is organizing a two-day National Seminar on April 25 and 26, 2024 at Pragjyotish College, Guwahati, Assam. The seminar is titled: Use of Technical Terminology in Humanities and Social Sciences in the context of NEP 2020. The chief purpose of this seminar will be to enhance a better understanding and application of technical terminology in subjects of humanities and social sciences.

## About the institution

Pragjyotish College, founded on 1st September 1954, is the first college established in Guwahati, the largest metropolis in Northeast India, after Independence.
