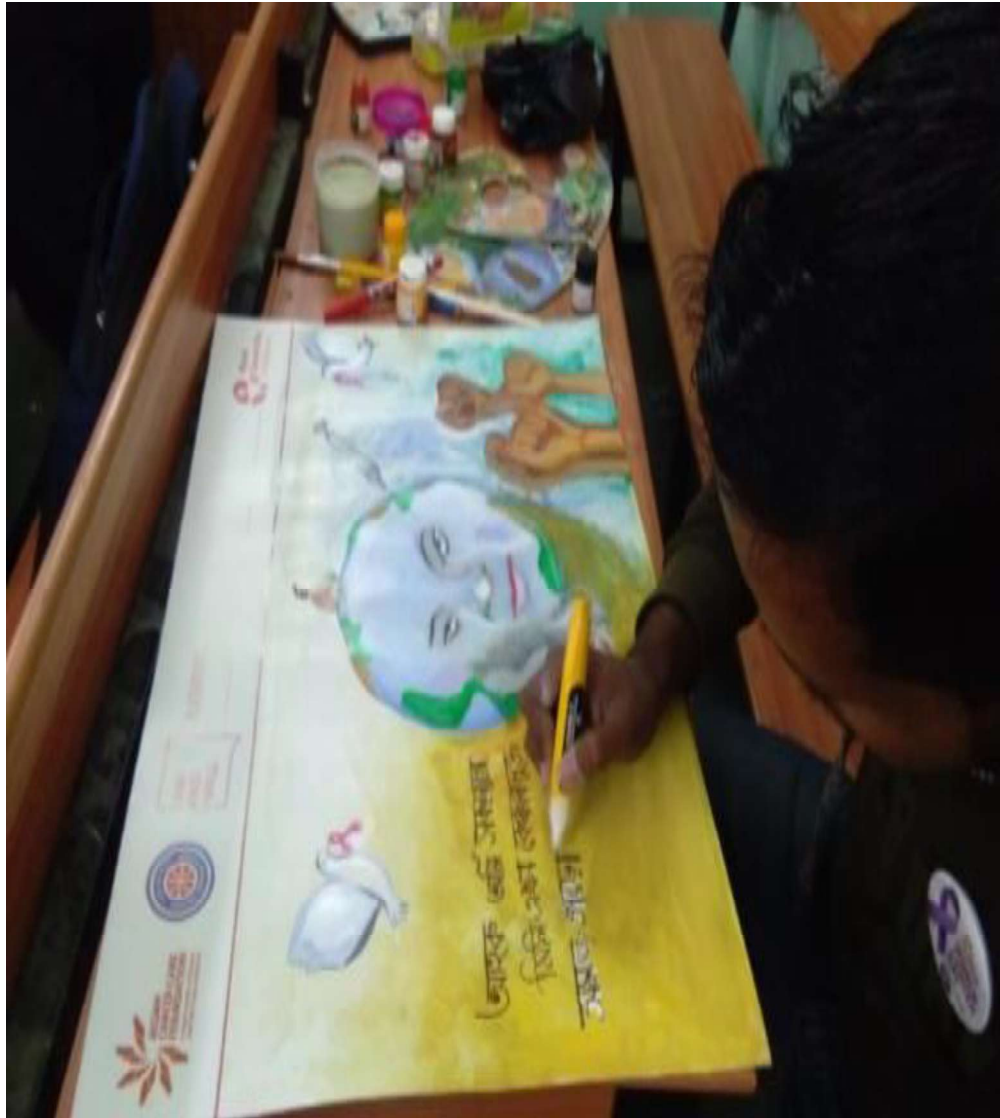

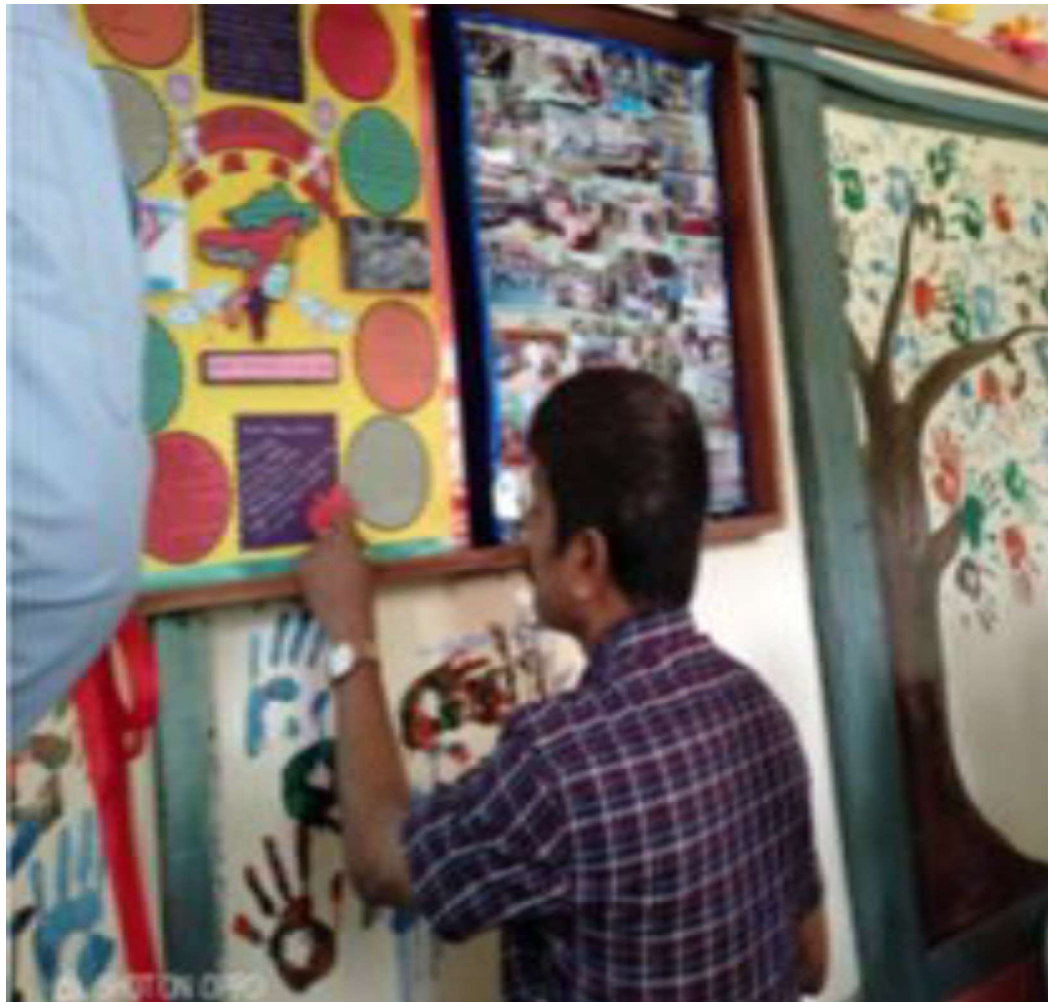

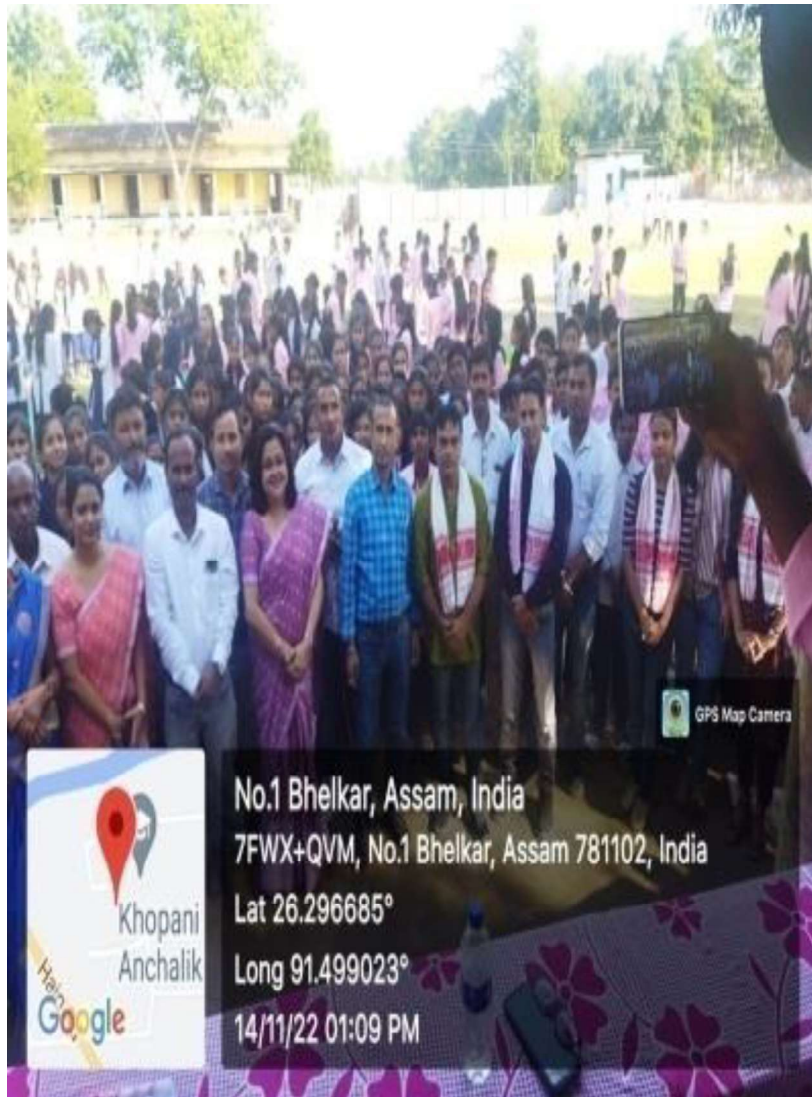

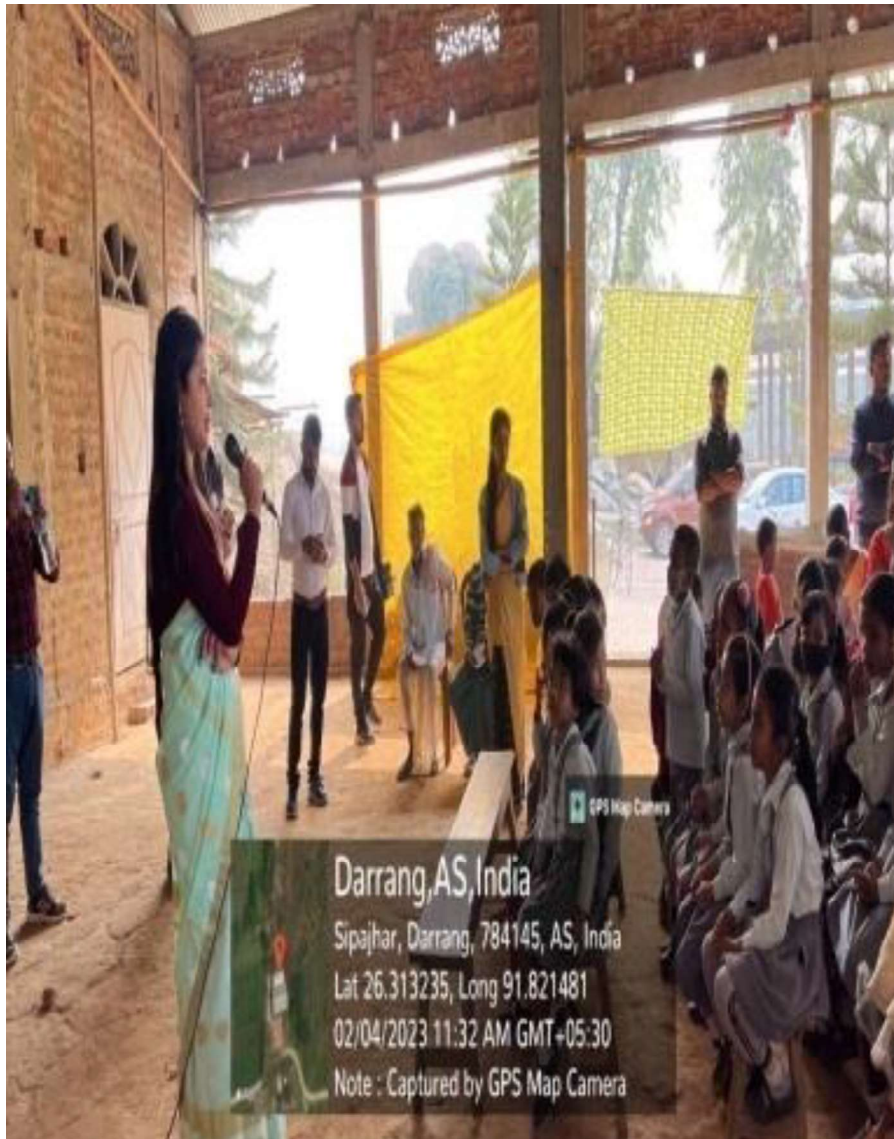

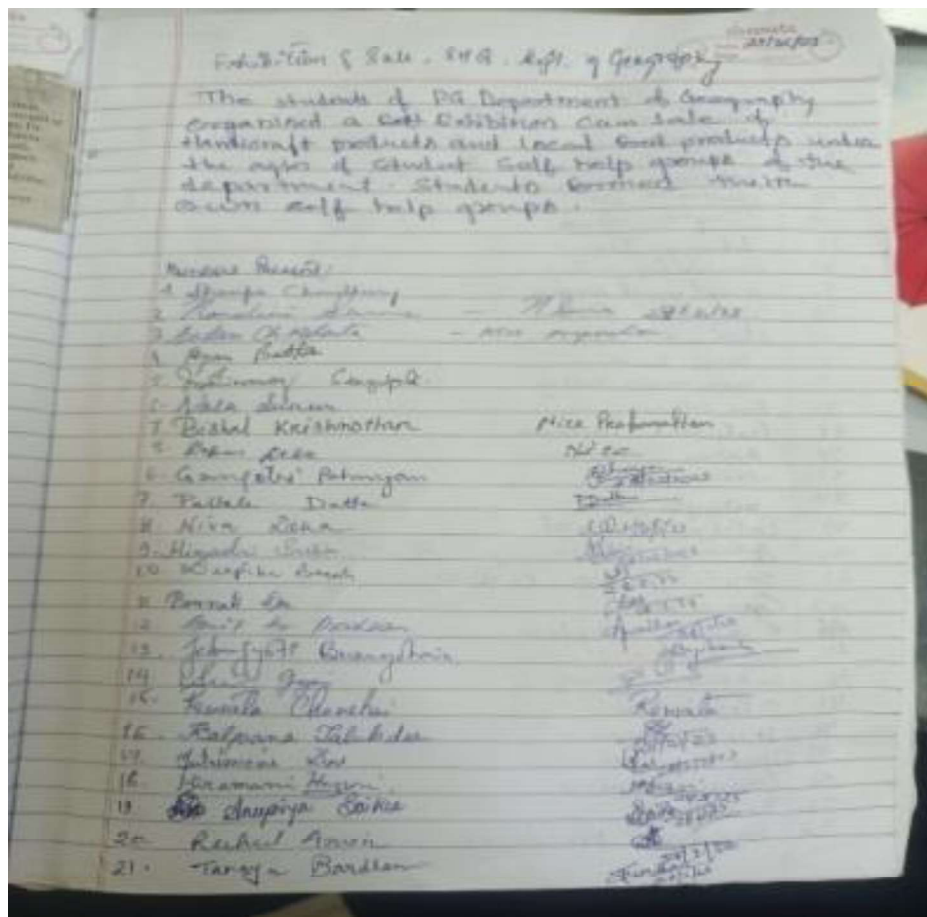

Event Name- Water quality testing in the fringe Area of Pragjyotish College

Report-Drinking water samples from 50 locations of outskirts areas of Pragjyotish College had been collected on 2/11/2023. Total five groups of students guided by their teachers collected these samples. The areas covered were: North of Santipur main road (Team A), South of Santipur main road (Team B), East of Bharalu river (Team C), West of Bharalu river (Team D) and South of Bharalu river (team E). The water samples were analysed by the Department of Chemistry, Pragjyotish College, where six parameters were taken for analysis. These parameters include pH, Conductivity, TDS (Total Dissolved Solids), Total hardness, Chloride and Iron. Again three parameters namely Fluoride, Arsenic and Lead were analysed for three samples randomly out of 50 samples to measure the toxicity. It has been reported that the results were within the normal range, and the same had been informed to the house-owner accordingly.
